Later in his life, Russell said he regretted his participation in killing wolves early in his cowboy career. You can see the development of his attitude toward nature and wildlife as you look at his work as he ages and matures. His attitude toward hunting changed, as well. Later in his career, Russell's devotion to nature is apparent in much of his subject matter featured wildlife and "ma nature," as he lovingly called it.
